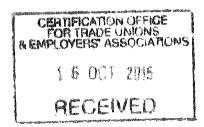

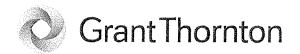

REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT AUDITOR TO THE MEMBERS OF

THE UNION OF COUNTRY SPORTS WORKERS

We have audited the AR 21 of The Union of Country Sports Workers for the period ended 30 June 2015 which comprise the general fund and the balance sheet and the supporting notes included in the AR 21. This Annual Return has been prepared under the accounting policies set out therein.

This report is made solely to the Union's members, as a body, in accordance with the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992. Our audit work has been undertaken so that we might state to the Union's members those matters we are required to state to them in an auditor's report and for no other purpose.
