Thank you for your email dated 2 April 2015 requesting information on software licences at the Homes and Communities Agency (HCA). For ease we have answered each of your questions separately below.

If so what is used for software usage metering? The HCA uses Snow for software usage metering.

7. Do you use a software asset management tool? As above, Snow is the HCA's software asset management tool.
