

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY DEFINITIVE MAP ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Nottinghamshire County Council (Owthorpe Footpath Nos. 11, 12, 13, 14 & 15 and Kinoulton Footpath No. 22) Modification Order 2005 proposes to modify the Order by providing for the following modifications:

- In the Schedule to the Order, Part I, modify the description of Footpath No. 13 to read "*Commencing from a point SK 66973301 at the junction with Kinoulton Lane and proceeding for a distance of approximately 400 metres in a generally southerly direction to a point SK 67013260 at the junction with Kinoulton Lane*".
- In the Schedule to the Order, Part II, Modify the description of Footpath No. 13 to read "*Commencing from a point SK 66973301 at the junction with Kinoulton Lane and proceeding for a distance of approximately 400 metres in a generally southerly direction on an earth surface across fields to a point SK 67013260 at the junction with Kinoulton Lane and having a minimum width of 1 metre throughout the whole of its length*".
- Amend the Order Map accordingly.

A copy of the Order as submitted and a copy of the Order showing the proposed modification together with the Inspector's Order decision dated 30 October 2015 have been deposited at the offices of Nottinghamshire County Council, Trent Bridge House, Fox Road, West Bridgford, Nottingham, NG2 6BJ and Cotgrave Library, Cotgrave Shopping Centre, Cotgrave, Nottingham, NG12 3JQ and may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours.
