Thank you for your email of 5th February 2015 requesting the following information:

I am seeking information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, in respect of fuel pipelines are located within the vicinity (15 miles radius) of the village of Misson, Nottinghamshire.

If there are any such pipelines, I would like to know the approximate routes, shown on a (ordinance survey or equivalent) map of the area; I understand that the precise routing of pipelines is a matter of national security, and as such would like to limit the accuracy to within nearest 75 m of the actual route of any pipelines.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000.

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD), and I can confirm that the information falling within scope of your request is held. However, it is also available on a public website, www.linsearchbeforeudig.co.uk, which is a free resource providing members of the public with details of the locations of underground pipelines and other assets from around 45 providers, including the Oil and Pipelines Agency (OPA).

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request

for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
