CHILD BOOST PARENTAL PERMISSION CARD

QUESTION TOPICS

The Department for Culture, Media and Sport and its partner organisations are interested in the experiences and views of children aged 11-15. DCMS need to understand how much time children spend doing sports activities – both in and out of school – so that they can improve the opportunities available to them.

The interviewer will ask your child questions about the following:

- Taking part in sports and recreational activities
- The types of activities your child's school offers
- Whether your child has taken part in any competitive sport

The interview asks about doing these activities in the last 12 months, 4 weeks, and 7 days.

In addition, we will also ask about their current level of happiness.

The interview will take around 15 minutes, including some time to ask you some questions about your household.

At your child's request, the interviewer will stop the interview at any time or skip any question they do not want to answer.

Everything your child says will be recorded in the strictest confidence.
