Some benefits of using the Digital service to make a claim

- Customers get a decision quicker than by post
- Available 24 hours a day 7 days per week
- Only takes around 20 minutes to complete
- Easy completion on a mobile phone or tablet

What happens after the claim is sent?

The online claim is received in the Carer's Allowance Unit as soon as it is sent. A letter will be sent to the person being cared for to let them know a claim by someone caring for them has been made. The customer will get an email if they include their email address in their application.
