NOTICE is hereby given that:


In accordance with section 19(3) of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 (as amended), and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England has declared that:

The land having a total area of 29.22 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the Parishes of Bottesford and Woolsthorpe by Belvoir in the Counties of Leicestershire and Lincolnshire and shown cross hatched and un-shaded on the attached map (which land was included in the Muston Meadows National Nature Reserve No. 2 Declaration made by Natural England (or any of its statutory predecessors) on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July 2006) has ceased to be managed as a nature reserve.

This Declaration may be referred to as the Muston Meadows National Nature Reserve No. 3 Declaration 2016.

Certified copies of the Muston Meadows National Nature Reserve No. 3 Declaration 2016 have been deposited for public inspection free of charge for one month during normal office hours at the offices of Leicestershire County Council at County Hall, Leicester Road, Glenfield, Leicester LE3 8RA; Lincolnshire County Council at County Offices, Newland, Lincoln, LN1 1YL and at the offices of Natural England at APEX Court, City Link, Nottingham NG2 4LA.
