

Annex B: Impact Assessment Riverside Primary School

Basic Need – forecast Reception Year surpluses/shortfalls

1. The table below shows the forecast shortfall in Reception Year places in the free school's likely catchment area. The data has been provided by the relevant local authorities via the department's 2013 School Capacity (SCAP) survey. Although the SCAP13 data shows there is currently no basic need from 2016/17 onwards the LA are fully supportive and have actively pushed for this school to open. The data does not take into account the plans for 10,800 new homes being built in the immediate vicinity of the school.

2 Data from the 2014 SCAP survey is currently being quality-assured by DfE analysts and is expected to be ready before the end of February. However, analysts' initial assessment of the data is that the forecast shortfall in Reception Years places will get worse for 2018/19.

Impact assessment for Riverside Primary on local schools

1. We have looked at 5 primary schools within a 0.8 mile radius from the temporary site of Riverside Primary School (permanent site is located 0.2 miles away from the temporary). We have concluded that Riverside Primary School will have a minimal impact on 1 school and moderate impact on 4 schools.
