I refer to your planning consultation on this proposal dated December 2013. I was hoping to request some additional clarification as the planning application will be discussed at next months Planning Applications Committee. The recommendation is to refuse the application and this is partly due to aviation impact.

It would be useful to know ahead of the Committee if the proposed development can be amended in any way to allow the MOD to remove any objection. So, for example, whether a reduction in a height of the turbines would suffice or whether if the turbines are re-located and if so how far they would need to be moved to avoid any impact on the radar service?

I understand from the developer that such amendments would not be sufficient however it would be very useful to have some additional information on the basis for the objection.
