### Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request

You asked for the following information from the Government Legal Department (“the Department”):

Could you confirm that the deceased and the relative of my partner are one and the same person and if so could you please release any more information about her?

Your request will be dealt with by the Bona Vacantia Division (“the Division”) under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I have interpreted part of your request to mean that you require any genealogical information concerning the deceased.

The Division holds all the information that you have requested.

The Division holds the deceased’s birth certificate. The event took place on 07/06/1926 in Stockport. We hold information on file provided by the Benefits Agency confirming the deceased’s date of birth as 07/06/1926 and that she was divorced.

The Bona Vacantia Unclaimed Estates List will be amended to include these details.

All other genealogical information about the deceased held by the Division has been published on the unclaimed estates list.
