Further to your email of 6 August and my letter of 1 September regarding your request for the following information:

"We routinely analyse the "Spend over £25,000" spreadsheets that all Government Departments disclose under Transparency Guidelines.

We have analysed M.O.D. data from April 2012 onwards, and I am surprised that there are no payments disclosed to:

- *Kier/Balfour Beatty Joint Venture – MOD awarded £121 million contract*
- *Skanska - £250 million contract to build the Defence College of Logistics*

I am aware that The Defence Infrastructure Organization is responsible for the MOD Estate within the UK but not expenditure is disclosed on the Ministry of Defence website www.gov.uk/government/collections/mod-finance-transparency-dataset.

*Please can you provide files relating to disclosure of actual monthly invoice expenditure (Date, Amount, Supplier & Description) in **CSV or XLS** format for the months April 2012 to June 2015 For The Defence Infrastructure Organisation.*

Ideally, I require information covering all levels of expenditure, however, information covering expenditure above £25,000 will suffice if necessary."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found at Annex A for Keir Construction and Annex B for Skanska.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
