We can confirm that Newland Homes are a Help to Buy (HtB) house builder. HtB is an equity loan scheme delivered by the Homes and Communities Agency (HCA). Please note that assistance provided via HtB is seen as being given to the member of the public and not the house builder. The HCA enters into a mortgage with the buyer/member of the public for each loan.

However Newland Homes have completed 48 HtB sales with 2.1m of equity loan funding to the individuals.
