FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request submitted to Highways England on the 21st of August 2015 regarding Optac3.

Highways England (formerly the Highways Agency) tendered a contract in 2010 for tachograph analysis software and then tendered an extension to the contract in 2013. The tender was one by one of the Highways Agency's partners, Computacentre, who subcontracted the work to another supplier who manage, develop and test and are responsible for the verification of the software. Highways England does not directly use the software but liaises and allows local police forces to use the software on through their contract with Computaserve. We would encourage you to pursue this information with our supplier who will be better positioned to answer technical questions relating to the software.
