Thank you for your e-mail of 22 June asking for information regarding aircraft movements at RAF Linton on Ouse.

You requested the following information:

“.....for RAF Linton-on-Ouse:

Total number of aircraft movements 1 Jan to 31 Dec 14 inc

Total number of aircraft movements 1 Jan to 31 May 15 inc

Max number of movements in any one day during period 1 Jan to 31 Dec 14 inc

Max number of movements in any one day during period 1 Jan to 31 May 15 inc”

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held and is shown in the table below.

<i>Total Aircraft Movements</i>	30,146	11,405
<i>Maximum on a single day</i>	268	230

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
