NO 3 DECLARATION 2016

The land shown un-hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map A has already been declared a National Nature Reserve in the Sherwood Forest National Nature Reserve No.1 Declaration 2002, and No. 2 Declaration 2007.

In accordance with section 19(3) of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 (as amended), and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England hereby declares that the land having a total area of 199.91 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the parish of Perlethorpe cum Budby in the county of Nottinghamshire and shown cross hatched and un-shaded on the attached map B (which land was included in the Sherwood Forest National Nature Reserve No. 2 Declaration made by Natural England on the 21st day of March 2007) is no longer the subject of a nature reserve agreement.

Furthermore, the land having a total area of 200.14 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the parish of Perlethorpe cum Budby in the county of Nottinghamshire and shown single hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map C is held by the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds, a body approved by Natural England, and is being managed as a nature reserve.

Natural England is satisfied that the said land is of national importance.

In pursuance of section 35(1) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England hereby declares the land referred to herein and more particularly shown on map C attached hereto, a National Nature Reserve.

This Declaration may be referred to as the Sherwood Forest National Nature Reserve No. 3 Declaration 2016.
