I am treating your correspondence as a request for ormation under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed him the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that some of the information in scope of y request is held.

However, the search facility within the Armed Forces Memorial Database (AFMD) will only allow a seach using the first three digits of the post code. We have therefore been unable to complete a trace using the information you provided.

However, under Section 16 (Advice and Assistance) of the FOIA, a search has been Completed for fatalities from the following postcode areas: DH1-Durham, DH2-Birtley, Chester-le Street, Ouston, Pelton, DH3- Birtley, Chester-le-Street, Great Lumley, DH7-Brandon, Burnhope, Esh Winning, Lanchester, Langley Park, Sacriston, Ushaw Moor, DH9-Dipton and Stanley. I have attached a copy of the results following this search.

The information provided is based on the place of birth. This means that an individual who for example was born in London but grew up in Chester-le-Street would not have been

I should point out that the Armed Forces Memorial Database (AFMD) was created using Casualty Files and Lists as source documents and is not to be regarded as a validated Source of historical information. Some errors have been found and Defence Business Services is keen to ensure that the information published is correct and welcome being told of any anomalies or errors.

Please note that any request for an internal revew must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach infomal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an intrnal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the pressions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Infration Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review proces has been completed.
