## **NO 5 DECLARATION 2015**

The land shown un-hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map A has already been declared a National Nature Reserve in the Hartland Moor National Nature Reserve No. 1 Declaration 1954, No. 2 Declaration 1958, No. 3 Declaration 1968 and No. 4 Declaration 1985.

In pursuance of section 19(3) of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England hereby declare that the land having a total area of 171.66 hectares or thereabouts situated in the Parishes of Arne and Corfe Castle in the County of Dorset and shown crosshatched black on the attached map B (which land was included in the Hartland Moor National Nature Reserve No. 3 Declaration made by the Nature Conservancy on the 12 th day of March 1968) has ceased to be held and managed by Natural England as a nature reserve.

And in pursuance of section 35(1) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England hereby declare the land having a total area of 171.66 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the Parishes of Arne and Corfe Castle in the County of Dorset and shown single hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map C is held by the National Trust, a body approved by Natural England and is being managed as a nature reserve and declare the said land a National Nature Reserve.

Natural England is satisfied that the said land is of national importance.

This Declaration may be referred to as the Hartland Moor National Nature Reserve No. 5 Declaration 2015.
