Thank you for your email of 20 September 2016 requesting the following information:

“ . . . a list of all projects which have been issued to contractors(Current, awarded and upcoming) under the Next Generation Estate Contracts (NGEC) Regional Capital Works Framework – East Midlands and Eastern England.”

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).
