

# The Mansion House Scholarship Scheme

The Mansion House Scholarship Scheme exists to fund scholarships for students and young business executives from overseas to travel to the United Kingdom to study or to undertake training or work experience in the Financial Services Sector.

# Areas/Fields of Study and Work

- Masters' level or equivalent in Financial Services related topics at British Universities Important. Applicants must have secured their own offer of admission (preferably starting in 2016).
- Training courses or internships in companies/institutions in the Financial Services sector in City of London
  Important. Applicants are responsible for finding vacancies for courses or business training attachments in the City.

#### **Key Eligibility Criteria**

- Applicants must be graduates with at least a Bachelor's degree or higher
- Applicants working in or hoping to pursue careers in Financial Services sector
- Applicants must be Korean national currently resident in the Republic of Korea

## **Application Requirements**

Mansion House Scholarship Application Form must be submitted to <u>Bradley.Jones@fco.gov.uk</u> by 17:00, 31 May 2016. Applications submitted after this deadline shall not be considered. Shortlisted candidates would be contacted directly for an interview.
