Description of change:

Data item 200658 childcare places was introduced in RFC 743. However, at that time, it was not noticed that the XML Tag <ChildcarePlaces> was in use by data item 200024 childcare facilities indicator.

As this data item (200024) records different data than data item 200658, the XML tag – and matching data item name, now need to be amended.

The XML Tag for data item 200658 will be amended from <ChildcarePlaces> to <NoOfChildcarePlaces> and the data item name will also change from 'Childcare places' to 'Number of childcare places'

Reason for change (including benefits):

There are, currently, two identical XML Tags which record different data. This will lead to issues with the correct return of data.
