PROVISION OF REQUESTED INFORMATION

Thank you for your request for information about the import of 8 chimpanzees, which we received on 21 September 2016. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

“The CITES permit applications and the granted CITES permits for the proposed import in 2016 of 8 chimpanzees (we believe one now to be deceased, so it could be 7 chimpanzees) from the USA to the United Kingdom.”

Please see attached at Appendix 1 the CITES permit application.

Please see attached at Appendix 2 the granted CITES permits.

Information has been redacted on the attached Appendices under Section 40(2) and 40(3)(a)(i) of the Freedom of Information Act (2000).

Section 40(2) and 40(3)(a)(i) refers to other people’s personal information. Some of the information contained within the requested documents has been withheld under section 40(2) and 40(3)(a)(i) (third party personal data) of the FOIA as the information constitutes personal data relating to a third party. Section 40(2) and 40(3)(a)(i) of the FOIA provides that personal data relating to third parties is exempt information if disclosure would breach the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA).

APHA consider that disclosure of this information is likely to breach the first data protection principle in Schedule 1 of the DPA, which relates to the fair and lawful processing of personal data, in two ways. First, disclosure would not constitute ‘fair’ processing of the personal data, second, disclosure would not satisfy any of the conditions for data processing set out in Schedule 2 to the DPA. Therefore, we have

concluded that this information is exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the FOIA.

Information disclosed in response to this FOI request is releasable to the public. In keeping with the spirit and effect of the FOIA and the government's Transparency Agenda, this letter and the information disclosed to you may be placed on GOV.UK, together with any related information that will provide a key to its wider context. No information identifying you will be placed on the GOV.UK website.
