Application for a licence under the Welfare of Wild Animals in Travelling Circuses (England) Regulations 2012

Thank you for your application for a licence under the Welfare of Wild Animals in Travelling Circuses (England) Regulations 2012 received in this office on 28 January 2015.

2016 Tour itinerary

The Circus Licensing Panel was concerned to note that you currently plan to begin your 2016 tour on 8th February 2016. As you know, in her letter of 22nd December 2015, Sue Ellis stated that, given the suspension that had occurred during your current licence, if you wished to continue touring England with wild animals after your current licence expired we would expect you to have applied for, and received, a new licence before your 2016 touring season begins. The Panel has seen your proposed tour itinerary and notes that your plans might not abide with this stipulation, in particular that you are planning to move your animals from Spalding, your first site of the year, before we have awarded you a renewed licence. I would like to remind you of the Panel's earlier stipulation and to confirm the Panel's position remains unchanged.

Application for a renewed licence

Unfortunately, we cannot proceed with your application for a renewed licence as the following documents did not provide the required level of detail:

- The preventative health care plans are not fully comprehensive; for example, they have no information or detail on vaccinations. Sue Ellis' letter of 16 November 2015 provided guidance on what we would expect to see in revised health care plans. I repeat the relevant paragraph below:

Preventative Medicine

This section of your care plans should ensure it includes all details of all preventive medicine regimes planned, as well as those being undertaken, such as vaccinations and worming. It should also include sufficient details of the health monitoring of the animals, such as regular checks of the animals' weights, with plans in place to ensure any unexpected changes in

weight are discussed with a vet and addressed as appropriate. Any actions or treatments undertaken should also be recorded.

- None of the health care plans appear to have been signed by your lead vet. All documents should be agreed with your lead vet and as some of these documents have now been revised, we will require the documents to be agreed and signed by your lead vet, before we can progress your application.
- On the camel Kachana's individual record, we note that a course of antibiotics and pain killers was administered in July 2015 (including a drug 'Viyest' which is not listed under the Veterinary Medicines Directorate Product information database). The record is not clear as to why Kachana was treated then and whether this was done under veterinary care. This, and the status of the drug 'Viyest', needs to be clarified. Your licence application cannot be processed any further, or an inspection arranged, until we receive the above information.

Next steps

Given the issues previously raised with you and the suspension that occurred during the current licence, the Panel is concerned to avoid a situation where your current licence expires without a new licence having been granted and with your wild animals on tour. Accordingly, and in the interest of processing your licence application as quickly as possible, the Panel asks you to do the following:

- Supply all of the information requested above by **10th February 2016** at the latest; and
- confirm, by return, that you will not move from Spalding, your first site of the year, until your application for a renewed licence has been approved.

The Panel acknowledges that your current licence expires on 12th March 2016. However, given past welfare concerns and the recent suspension of your existing licence, if the new welfare concerns identified by weaknesses in your application for a renewed licence are not addressed satisfactorily the Secretary of State reserves her right to suspend your current licence in the event of your refusal to comply with the above request. Clearly, should you adopt that position without providing a satisfactory explanation; this may have implications with regard to your current application for a renewed licence.

I would like to remind you that you must not operate a travelling circus with wild animals without holding a valid licence. If you did decide to continue touring in England without a valid licence, you would need to remove your wild animals from the stock list of the circus and ensure that they do not perform and that they are off display at all times. Under the Animal Welfare Act 2006, the maximum penalty for operating a travelling circus with wild animals without a licence is 6 months' imprisonment or an unlimited fine or both. If your wild animals are dangerous wild animals within the meaning of the Dangerous Wild Animals Act 1976, they will need to be licensed under that Act which is administered by your local authority.

The calf had a lump on it's knee. To treat the animal, I injected it with 5ml of Pen & Strep, 3ml of Meloxidyl and 2ml of Vitesel.

Application for a licence under the Welfare of Wild Animals in Travelling Circuses (England) Regulations 2012

Thank you for the further information provided in your response to my letter of 4th February regarding your application for a licence under the Welfare of Wild Animals in Travelling Circuses (England) Regulations 2012. We await the signed copies of the revised papers agreed with your lead vet.

In the meantime, the Circus Licensing Panel had further queries regarding the further information provided.

- With regard to the use of the drug Vitesel, the email from the vet was not attached, rather a copy of text was included. The Panel has requested a copy of the actual veterinary records, recording when this drug was used, signed by the vet.

Revised Health Care Plans

- The Panel has noted that the electronic plans submitted and considered during the panel meeting are not signed by your vet. Please ensure that your vet reviews the plans and signs them accordingly. The comments below are based on the information provided, however the Panel is only able to make paper-based comments. Your vet is best placed to advise on care plans for the animals under his/her care.
- The Panel noted that your preventative medicine plans rely on your close contact with the animals. Given that our own inspector has recently had to request that you seek veterinary care for the camel Kachana; and that the pregnancy of the camel Sabia went unnoticed, the Panel suggests that your actual checks be formalised in your preventative medicine plans (i.e. animal checked daily and action taken when needed; presence of worms checked daily and action taken when needed, etc).
- The Panel noted that your preventative medicine plans make no mention of vaccinations. If vaccinations have been considered, but a decision not to vaccinate has been made, this and the justification should be properly recorded in the plans.

- The Panel noted your suggestion that you plan to use tape to monitor the weight of the animals. You will need to ensure that your individual plans record these measurements and that, where any changes are identified, these are followed up as necessary with a vet

Next steps

While waiting for the above confirmations, we propose to proceed to the next step in your application. We have appointed [REDACTED] as the inspector to undertake the necessary first inspection of your circus. The purpose of this inspection is to allow you to demonstrate that the required licensing conditions would be complied with. You will be charged for the cost of this inspection once it has taken place. A successful inspection must be completed and paid for before we can issue you with a licence.

The inspector will make contact with you shortly, either by phone or email, to arrange a mutually convenient time to undertake the inspection.

As you know, the findings of the inspection will then be considered by a panel of officials on behalf of the Secretary of State. Based on the findings, the panel will recommend whether you will be issued with a licence or whether further work on your application first needs to be undertaken. Please be aware that any further work may require a further inspection, for which you will be charged, before a licence can be issued.

2016 Tour Itinerary

As you know, the Panel has concerns about your plan to begin touring before you have had your licensed renewed. The Panel will attempt to assess your application as quickly as possible. However, in the event that the Panel are unable to assess your application before your proposed move to your first touring site at Boston on the 21st February, if you wish to move your circus as planned, then we would expect you to remove your animals from your stock list and return them to your winter quarters, until we have assessed your application. If your wild animals are dangerous wild animals within the meaning of the Dangerous Wild Animals Act 1976, they may need to be licensed under that Act which is administered by your local authority.

Thanks. I can confirm that we did receive the picture of the signed copy of the preventative medicine plan for Zebedee from your vet. I can also confirm we have now also received all the other signed paperwork through the post. We had to arrange for it to be all scanned in, so it can be filed.

In terms of the further work required in [REDACTED] letter of 11th February; we now have an acceptable copy of the email from your vet regarding the use of the drug Vitesel. As we said, all we had before was a copy of the text, which – with all due respect - could have been written by anyone.

The other three points in the letter still need to be addressed. I would imagine that the points regarding any consideration of vaccinations and the recording the tape measurements could be covered off in the email from your lead vet you mention below. In terms of our request to formalise the checks you mention in the preventative medicine plans, you may need to discuss this with your lead vet, and then get him to sign of the revised plans again, once a formal pattern of checks have been included. We'd be happy to receive the 5 signed copies by email again, as your lead vet did with the signed copy of preventative medicine plan for Zebedee. We wouldn't need to see all the other documents signed off again.
