MULTILATERAL AGREEMENT M269

Under paragraph 1.5.1 of Annex A of ADR, concerning marking of UN numbers on LPG cylinders

- 1) This agreement concerns the marking of refillable cylinders for the carriage of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) of UN 1011, UN 1075, UN 1965, UN 1969 or UN 1978.
- 2) By derogation from 1.6.1.25 the requirements of 5.2.1.1, related to the minimum size of the UN number marking digits shall be fulfilled at the latest at the time of the next periodic inspection.
- 3) This agreement shall be valid until 30th June 2018 for the carriage on the territories of those ADR Contracting Parties signatory to this agreement. If it is revoked before then by one of the signatories, it shall remain valid until the above mentioned date only for the carriage on the territories of those ADR Contracting parties signatory to this agreement which have not revoked it.
