Dear Sir/Madam,

to record my continued objection to all aspects of these proposed windfarms, and especially the associated Mid-Wales Connection project which continues to blight Shropshire.

Due to inefficency of onshore wind, lack of economic sustainability without subsidy, lack of use of British engineering and manufacturing and the short lifetime of these installations with resulting devastation left, I call upon the secretary of state to do the following:

- -uphold the decision to refuse planning for both windfarms and the Mid-Wales Connection. This will ensure that future windfarms to be built many miles from power lines also do not go ahead.
- ensure that no further appeals can be made, i.e. that the refusal decision is final.
- do not reopen the public inquiry. Refuse planning for good. Enough public money has been wasted on this.
