FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 REQUEST REF: 0080-16

Thank you for your email of 25 January asking for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You asked:

Could you please provide your annual totals for 2013, 2014 & 2015 for monies/contributions as paid towards the pensions of your senior civil servants?

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed the search for the information which you requested.

I can confirm that the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) does hold information relevant to your request. We have interpreted your request for senior civil servants as meaning the FCO Board.

Under section 21 of the FOI Act, we are not required to provide information in response to a request if it is already reasonably accessible. The information requested is available to view in the annually published FCO Accounts report as follows:-:
