Inspection details	The GM Inspectorate carried out an inspection of this 2016-sown research trial of GM <i>Camelina sativa</i> (camelina) at the commencement of flowering. Checks were made on the stand density of the plants making up the pollen barrier, the stand density of the GM plants in the experimental plots, the size and layout of the trial, and the measures used to keep birds away from the experimental plots. All were in accordance with the requirements specified in the consent.
Report conclusions	The GM Inspectorate is content that the release is consistent with the conditions specified in the consent. No risks to human health or the environment, posed by the genetically modified organism, were identified.
