FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: MDP OFFICERS CURRENTLY SUSPENDED

We refer to your email dated 17 March 2016 which was acknowledged on 24 March 2016.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email of 17 March 2016 you requested the following information:

“I would like to know the number of police currently suspended and still entitled to their salary.

Could you specify when the suspension began and the salary and rank of the individual.”

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

There is currently one MDP officer, of the rank Police Constable, who is suspended and still entitled to their salary. The suspension began on 04/02/2016. We attach a list of the current MDP Constable pay scales at Annex A.

If you are not satisfied with this response or wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, London SW1A 2HB (email CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed. Further details of the role and powers of the Information Commissioner can be found on the Commissioner's website (<http://www.ico.org.uk>).
