Surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of the permit for Holfield Grange Duck Unit operated by Mr Christopher Hill.

The permit number is EPR/UP3430AC.

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state. We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

Key issues of the decision

An application was made by Mr Christopher Hill to surrender the permit EPR/UP3430AC for the operation of a duck rearing facility for the production of meat. The planning permission for the facility was not granted as the application was withdrawn due to highways requirements and local opposition, and therefore no construction works for the site was ever started.

This permit surrender is therefore a low risk surrender as there have been no activities carried out on site which are covered by the permit EPR/UP3430AC.
