Thank you for your email of 7 September 2015 requesting the following information:

*Once again you fail to notify me with the list of future dates, and what hunts are meeting and you do not provide a copy of terms and conditions that you give hunts.
May I request that you give me the full information so you comply with the freedom of information request.*

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that some information scope of your request is held.

Some of the information, a copy of a blank license to drag or trail hunt on MOD owned land can be found at Annex A. This includes the terms and conditions given to licensees who carry out hunts on MOD owned land.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note there are currently no future hunt dates planned on MOD owned land.

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
