Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request

You asked for the following information from the Government Legal Department ("the Department"):

I see that you have now updated the spreadsheet for this case - and also added details about two certificates that were found in the deceased's possession. Would it be possible for me to see those? The address of Robert Ogilvie at death and the name of the informant would be helpful. Also I don't really know what a certificate of registration actually is, in terms of Ann Garrone, does it relate to naturalisation or something like that? Is there a home address on that one?

Your request will be dealt with by the Bona Vacantia Division ("the Division") under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Division holds all the information that you have requested.

The Certificate of Registration was issued due to the holder being of Italian Nationality. The holder lived at the following address:
