

Environment Agency permitting decisions

Part surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of part of the permit for Huntsman Polyurethanes (UK) Limited operated by Huntsman Polyurethanes (UK) Limited.

The permit number is EPR/BS8656IX.

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

Changes to permit conditions	There has been no change to permit conditions as a result of the partial surrender.	✓

Extent of the surrender application	The operator has provided a plan showing the extent of the part of the facility that is to be surrendered. A new site boundary plan is included in the surrender notice. We consider this plan to be satisfactory.	✓
Pollution risk	We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid a pollution risk resulting from the operation of the regulated facility in the part of the site to be surrendered.	✓
Satisfactory state	We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to return the area to be surrendered to a satisfactory state. In coming to this decision we have had regard to the state of the site before the facility was put into operation.	✓
