FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OFFENCES

I acknowledge receipt of your e-mail dated 5 March 2015, which we are treating as request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

“The number of domestic violence offences, or offences which have a domestic violence flag, that were detected through a non-sanction detection using restorative justice and community resolution, broken down by offence description, in the following years: 2009; 2010; 2011; 2012; 2013; 2014?”

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held:

There was one Common Assault offence record from 2010 that was dealt with by way of Community Resolution.

If you are not satisfied with this response or wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, London SW1A 2HB (email CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed. Further details of the role and powers of the Information
