Compliance Rating Methodology

1. Background

The SSRO has created a methodology to measure defence contractor and Ministry of Defence (MOD) compliance with their duties under the Single Source Procurement Framework, from which data and rating scores will be produced. These results will be assessed and published in the SSRO's Compliance Report.

The SSRO will carry out compliance assessments throughout the year, and publish these at least annually in January. The SSRO may also decide to publish its assessments each quarter during the year. The first Compliance Report will be published in January 2016.

2. Background

The SSRO has developed a process for measuring compliance with the single source procurement regime. This was supported by research into methodologies used by other regulators, credit rating agencies and other independent organisations.

The methodology requires the SSRO to scrutinise each contract, but does not require the SSRO to give full assurance that contracts meet all the Regulations.

The methodology is summarised below.

- Compliance by the MOD and by contractors is measured through three indicators or indicator groups.
- MOD compliance is measured through indicators that relate to its duty to notify the SSRO of any qualifying defence contracts (QDCs) and qualifying sub-contracts (QSCs), to verify reports, to notify the SSRO of verification within 30 days and to ensure consistent application of the allowable costs and contract rate requirements when entering into a QDC.
- Contractor compliance is measured through indicators relating to their duty to submit accurate reports to the SSRO and their compliance with the allowable costs and contract profit rate requirements.
- Assessments will be carried out for each contract, and for each set of supplier reports. This data will then be used to calculate MOD and contractor compliance.
- Scores will be averaged to produce an overall mark for the MOD and for individual contractors over the compliance measuring period. Averaged overall indicator ratings and scores will also be calculated to identify specific areas of good and poor compliance.
- Contract scores, including a breakdown of indicator scores, will also be published to identify contractor compliance where contractors have more than one contract in a year. Contractors' names will be published, while contracts will be anonymous.

3. Allowable costs and contract profit rate assessments

The SSRO will independently assess, through reports submitted by contractors, whether a contract is in line with the contract profit rate guidance, and whether there are any clearly non-allowable costs in the contract. Contractors' scores will be determined by the SSRO's assessment of whether reports comply with the SSRO's guidance. The MOD will be deemed to have not complied where it has agreed to, or failed to challenge, any identified breaches.

The SSRO will not provide full assurance, as it is for the MOD to ensure that contracts it enters into comply with the framework. For example, whether costs are allowable is often a matter for judgement, and the SSRO will only provide a full judgement when asked to do so when the matter is referred to it for an opinion or determination. However, if there are any costs that are clearly not allowable, and the SSRO becomes aware of these, then that will inform the assessment of compliance.

4. Communication with MOD and contractors

Where the SSRO has found that the MOD or a contractor is not compliant, the SSRO will write formally to ensure the affected party is fully aware of the SSRO's view, and that this will be reflected in the annual Compliance Report.

If, following this formal communication, an issue is resolved (for example a non-allowable cost is removed) via a referral, the issuing of a compliance notice or negotiations, the SSRO would note the resolution in the Compliance Report, and the matter would not affect the compliance rating. Opinions and determinations that result in a change to compliance assessments that have already been in included in a published compliance report will be amended in the following compliance report.

5. Information security

Where published results are broken down to contract level, contracts will be exclusively identified on an alphabetical basis (i.e. Contract A, Contract B etc.) to protect sensitive or confidential information.

6. Assessment process

Contract compliance

This will be measured as a series of 'ticks' and 'crosses' for each indicator, which represent compliance or non-compliance with the specified requirement.
