The Bushey Academy	Academy Sponsor Led	1,350	53%	Good	Moderate: The Bushey Academy opened in September 2009 (located 1.7 miles from the UTC site) and is co-sponsored by David Meller; it gained its 'good' judgment in December 2013. We believe the sponsor's plans to establish a collaborative partnership will significantly reduce the UTC's impact on Bushey Academy. The UTC is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school.
Westfield Academy	Academy Converter	1,362	65%	Good	Moderate: Westfield Academy Westfield is a multicultural comprehensive school catering for students aged 11-19. In November 2012 the school received a 'good' Ofsted rating and following this in September 2013 they converted to Academy status. Additionally, the University of Hertfordshire is working with the school who are also the university partner for the UTC. Therefore this will help to mitigate any impact the UTC may have on the school. The UTC is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school.
Francis Combey Academy	Academy Sponsor Led	1,170	50%	Requires Improvement	Moderate: Francis Combey Academy opened in September 2009 is an academy sponsor led, co-sponsored by the University of Hertfordshire. Although the school was judged as 'requires improvement' in their last inspection (November 2013) we believe the university will work in collaboration with the sponsors to ensure the UTC does not impact the school. The UTC is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school.
Northwood School	Academy Converter	1,476	73%	Good	Moderate: Northwood School converted to become an academy school on 1 February 2012 when its predecessor school was last inspected by Ofsted, it was judged to be a 'good' school. The school is located 4.4 miles from the UTC site which is more than the average distance (1.7 miles) travelled by pupils in Watford. The UTC is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school.
Hatch End High School	Academy Converter	1,850	62%	Good	Moderate: Hatch End High School is located 4.5 miles from the UTC site which is also more than the average distance travelled by pupils in Watford. In addition the school was judged 'good' by Ofsted in their recent inspection in November 2013. The UTC is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school.
