- This Order is made under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and is known as the Norfolk County Council (Wickmere) Modification Order 2015.
- The Order is dated 18 November 2015 and proposes to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding a Restricted Byway running between Lower Street and Footpath 6, Wickmere, as shown on the Order Map and described in the Order Schedule.
- In accordance with Paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the 1981 Act I have given notice of my proposal to confirm the Order with modifications to amend the status of the Order route to footpath rather than Restricted Byway.

Summary of Decision: The Order is confirmed subject to the modifications that I proposed previously.

Procedural Matters

- I held a public inquiry into this Order on Tuesday 27 September 2015 at Wickmere Village Hall. I made an unaccompanied site inspection on Monday 26 September when I was able to walk the whole of the Order route. It was agreed by all parties at the inquiry that a further accompanied visit was not necessary
- 2. In writing this decision I have found it convenient to refer to points marked on the Order Map. I therefore attach a copy of this map to which I have added an additional point (Point Z).
- 3. The Order Making Authority (OMA), Norfolk County Council chose to adopt a neutral stance at the inquiry. Wickmere Parish Council representatives took the lead in supporting the confirmation of the Order.
- 4. The effect of this Order if confirmed subject to the modifications I proposed in paragraph 40 of my interim decision issued on 10 October 2016 would be to add a footpath to the definitive map running from the U14362 road, Lower Street (Point A) generally north-eastwards along the driveway to the Old Rectory to its junction with Footpath 6 (Point C).
- 5. No objections have been made to the proposal following advertisement of the notice and deposit of the associated documents relating to the proposed modifications.

Conclusions

6. Bearing in mind the above, I conclude that the Order should now be confirmed subject to the modifications set out in paragraph 40 of my interim decision dated 10 October 2016.

Formal Decision

7. I confirm the Order subject to the following modifications:

In the Schedule to the Order, Parts I and II, delete the words <u>"Restricted Byway"</u> and insert <u>"Footpath"</u>.

Amend the Order Map accordingly.
