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## AUTHORIZED AMENDMENT

The RA 5600 Regulatory Series (Procedures for the Procurement of Aircraft Engines and their Accessories) and all known associated regulation has been reviewed by the MAA to address the accuracy, relevance and coherence of extant Propulsion System specific design, procurement and reporting policy. This has resulted in significant amendment to the RA 5600 Series, the withdrawal of several RAs in this series, the need to update numerous associated documents and the formal withdrawal of 4 unsupported legacy policy documents. Much of the extant policy was found not to be Propulsion System specific and addressed elswhere in the MAA Regulatory Publications (MRP), not airworthiness in intent, or no longer relevant. A summary of the changes to be made is below:

1. The renaming of the RA 5600 Regulatory Series to 'Propulsion System Design Requirements and Assurance'.

2. The substantial rewrite and renaming of RAs 5601, 5602, 5604 and 5615.

- 3. The withdrawal in toto of RAs 5603, 5605, 5607, 5608, 5610, 5612, 5613, 5614, 5616 and 5617.
- 4. The withdrawal of Def Stan 28-8, and APs 100E-01A, 100E-01B and 100E-02.

5. The Preparation of 21 RFCs and F765s to align all known associated documentation for submission on release of this NAA.
