I am writing regarding your request for information, received on 30 January 2015. In that request, you asked us for the following information:

I would like to know the following about the roads and highways you are responsible for:

- *The number of speed bumps:*

I can confirm that there are no speed bumps on the Highways Agency network.

- *The number of zebra crossings:*
- *The number of pedestrian crossings:*

In our inventory data we have 634 pedestrian crossings; 8 of those are classed as Zebra crossings, 391 are classed as Pelican crossings, 225 are classed as 'Other' and 10 are recorded as 'Not Specified', which is the inventory default setting.

- *The number of roundabouts*
- *The number of double roundabouts*

There are 594 sections of road in our database classed as roundabouts. We do not differentiate in the database between roundabouts and double roundabouts.

The Highways Agency is responsible for operating, maintaining and improving the strategic road network which incorporates the majority of England's network of motorways and major A roads. Other public roads in England are managed by local authorities. Roads in Scotland and Wales are the responsibility of Transport Scotland and the Welsh Assembly Government respectively.
