



The Technical Cooperation Program (TTCP) Collaborative Research for Enhanced Academic-TTCP Engagement (CREATE) call 2016

Postdoctoral Research Associate - Multi-modality Sensing and Information Fusion

The UK Ministry of Defence (MOD), in partnership with the TTCP nations, is seeking to fund a Research Associate at a UK university for a period of twelve months. This post will run in conjunction with four others, similarly constituted in Australia, Canada, New Zealand and the United States of America.

Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be supported by the UK host institution in which they wish to hold the post.
2. Applicants must have been awarded a doctoral degree or having a reasonable expectation that they will have submitted and had their thesis examined by 1 January 2017.
3. Applicants must be a UK or EEA national, or have completed a doctorate at a UK university. Any applicant who does not fall into one of these categories must demonstrate a strong prior association with the UK academic community, for example through already having been employed in a temporary capacity (longer than twelve months) at a UK university.

Number of Awards: 1

Duration of Award: Awards are for 1 year in the first instance

Funding: Awards are offered on a Full Economic Costing basis. There is no fixed amount awarded for the Fellowships and the value of award will vary depending on the host institution. Awards cover the salary of the Postdoctoral Research Associate to work full-time, small-scale research expenses, travel expenses, costs towards the time of a Principal Investigator (PI) and the host institution's estates and indirect costs.

Referee: Applicants must be supported by one self-nominated referee.

Closing Date: The deadline for applications for award in 2016-17 is at noon on 15th September 2016.

Application Process:

Each proposal is for one Research Associate, which must have a PI from a UK academic institution. Completed proposals should be submitted to postdocs@dstl.gov.uk and should include:

- completed application form
- CV of candidate (if known)
- CV of PI in the UK
- Academic reference
