#### **IHAT QUARTERLY UPDATE - JANUARY TO MARCH 2016**

#### Introduction and Aim

1. The aim of this document is to ensure that the public have access to relevant information that details the progress made by the IHAT. This includes noteworthy developments during the reporting period; the number of cases referred to the IHAT and the number of cases at each stage of the IHAT process. Information relating to the nature of the allegations and completed cases can be found elsewhere on the IHAT webpage.

#### Overview

2. Due to travel restrictions out with the control of the IHAT, there has been only one OP MENSA deployment during this period which saw 6 witnesses and 7 victims interviewed. Arrangements are in hand to overcome this issue and increase the number of interviews in the coming months. There is an enduring commitment to the assessment of cases provided by PIL and other legal representatives.

#### **IHAT Strategic Priorities:**

3. The current strategic priorities of the IHAT include:

- a. Allegations of unlawful killing in the custody of British Forces.
- b. Allegations of unlawful killing following contact with British Forces.
- c. Allegations of unlawful killing of juveniles.

d. Allegations of serious ill treatment including rape, sexual assaults and Grievous Bodily Harm.

e. Allegations of ill treatment where the war-crime threshold has been met.

#### **Cases Allocation 2016**

4. At 31 March 2016, the IHAT had received 3281 allegations of potential criminal behaviour; 981 of these allegations were screened out and did not progress to the investigation stage; 742 are still at the initial assessment stage. The IHAT is investigating allegations relating to 1558 potential victims, of which 288 are alleged unlawful killings and 1270 are alleged ill treatment ranging from common assault to serious sexual and violent assaults.

5. The IHAT has closed or is in the process of closing investigations into 59 allegations of unlawful killing. In 56 cases the allegation of criminal behaviour was not sustainable. Two soldiers were referred to the Director of Service Prosecutions for consideration of prosecution but discontinued on legal grounds and one case has been referred to the RAF Police for further investigation.

#### **Predicted Caseload**

6. The IHAT continues to review allegations of unlawful killing and ill treatment submitted by PIL and other legal representatives. These allegations have been subdivided into eleven caseloads in order to manage the receipt and flow of cases within the organisation. These are summarised as follows:
