How much have the Yorkshire organisations (or their controlled subsidiaries) individually, and in aggregate, which have been recipients of grants or loans from the HCA, spent on sponsoring horse racing in the last four years.

We have now had the opportunity to investigate your request and are writing to communicate that we do not hold the information above.
