# **ALTERNATIVE CARRIAGE PROVISIONS**

- 1 With the agreement of the inspection body the cylinders may be used for their full design life (as marked on the cylinder).
- 2. The cylinder shall remain suitable for purpose and continue to be inspected and tested in accordance with the relevant ADR and RID provisions.
- 3. The cylinder may only be used and carried in Great Britain.
