Surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of the permit for Pitt Poultry Farm operated by Banham Group Limited.

The permit number is EPR/EP3834UK.

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

Key issues of the decision

The applicant, Banham Group Limited, has provided an application for full surrender with supporting evidence that comprises:

- EPR Pitt Farm Doc 1 History of pollution incidents throughout the life of permit EP3834UK.
- EPR Pitt Farm Doc 2 Measures taken to remove pollution risk from the site.
- Additional supporting information received in response to a Request for Further Information (RFI) on 23/02/16 and 26/02/16.

The surrender application and supporting documentation aim to demonstrate that the site has been returned in a satisfactory state. Following our review of the surrender application and supporting information we, the Environment Agency, are satisfied that the operator, has provided sufficient evidence to demonstrate that the facility and site has been returned in a satisfactory state.
