THE THAMES WATER UTILITIES LIMITED (THAMES TIDEWAY TUNNEL) ORDER 2014 – VARIATION OF DEEMED MARINE LICENCE

On 3 September 2014 the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government and the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs made the Thames Water Utilities Limited (Thames Tideway Tunnel) Order 2014 ("the Order") which included at Schedule 15 a deemed marine licence ("DML") in accordance with section 149A of the Planning Act 2008 (as amended).

Following consultation with the Department for Communities and Local Government and the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, the MMO has undertaken to vary the DML in exercise of the powers conferred by section 72(3)(d) of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009.

Please find enclosed a notice of variation and a copy of the DML as varied for ease of reference. This documentation is publicly available on the MMO's website at https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/marine-licensing-nationally-significant-infrastructure-projects.

In accordance with Regulation 3 of The Marine Licensing (Notices Appeals) Regulations 2011, you may appeal the notice of variation to the First-tier Tribunal. If you wish to appeal then in accordance with Rule 22(1)(b) of the Tribunal Procedure (First-tier Tribunal)(General Regulatory Chamber) Rules 2009 (SI 2009/1976) you have 28 days from the date of the sending of the notice of variation to send or deliver a notice of appeal to the First-tier Tribunal.
