We have audited the financial statements of PTSC for the period ended

31 March 2015 which comprise the Income and Expenditure Account, Balance Sheet and related notes. These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable law and the accounting

This report is made solely to the Union members, as a body. Our audit work has been undertaken so that

we might report to the members those matters which we are required to state to them in an auditors' report

and for no other purpose. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we do not accept or assume responsibility to

anyone other than the Union and the Unions' members as a body, for our audit work, for this report, or for the opinions we have formed.

Respective responsibilities of union officers and auditors

As described in the statement of union officers' responsibilities on page 1, the Union's officers are The Union Officers are responsible for the preparation of the financial statements in accordance with applicable

law and accounting standards issued by the Accounting Standards Board. Our responsibility is to audit the

financial statements in accordance with relevant legal and regulatory requirements and International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland).

We report to you our opinion as to whether the financial statements give a true and fair view. We also report

to you if, in our opinion: proper books of account have been kept by the Union: whether we have obtained all the information and explanations we require for the purposes of our audit, and whether the Unions Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure account are in agreement with the books of account.

Opinion

Unqualified Opinion

In our opinion the financial statements give a true and fair view, in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Practice, of the state of the Union's affairs at 31 March 2015 and of its loss for the period then ended.
