Where 'puppies' were mentioned throughout the request, this was clarified that it should be corrected to 'dogs'. In addition the time period on request two was clarified as January 2014 to 9 November 2016, for the export figures.

Note all imports to Little Rascals Ltd and The Dairies was from the Republic of Ireland only.

The number of dogs exported from Little Rascals to any country in the world between 01/01/2014 to 10/11/2016 is zero. This includes any exports to Third Countries (non-EU) where an Export Health Certificate (EHC) would be required or for a consignment of more than 5 dogs to the EU where a TRACES ITAHC would be required.

This does not account for any that may have travelled to the EU under the Pet Travel Scheme where there may have been a consignment of 5 or less dogs. Such consignments would not require a TRACES ITAHC and would travel with a Pet Passport. APHA hold no record of such moves out of Great Britain under the Pet Travel Scheme to EU Member States.
