Analysis and examination of foods 20 - 24 April 2015 UNIVERSITY OF READING

Background

The Government Chemist Programme in LGC organises an annual fully residential week long postgraduate course on the work of the Public Analyst. The teaching consists of a mix of lectures, laboratory practical sessions and interactive exercises. Some of the delegates will be studying for the Mastership in Chemical Analysis, MChemA, the statutory qualification required to practice as a Public Analyst. Several short sessions are devoted to demystifying the exam process encouraging other delegates to consider taking the qualification. The course aims, in a two year cycle, to touch on most of the syllabus for the MChemA, awarded by the Royal Society of Chemistry following a three part, (A, B and C) series of examinations. Holders of a recognised MSc are exempt from Part A. Tuition fulfills a wide range of aims: it affords the novice an opportunity to begin to get to grips with the subject matter of the syllabus but also enable the experienced analyst to discuss finer points of practice with experts. It is viewed as a valuable opportunity to update current professional experience in food control practice.

Topics include food fraud, the new food labelling requirements, the Defra Food Authenticity programme, food allergen analysis, advanced DNA testing, microscopy and mycology, food law, certificate and report writing and sessions on fertilisers and feedingstuffs. *An evening interactive session offers training in court technique for the expert witness.*
