## **PROVISION OF REQUESTED INFORMATION**

Thank you for your 3 requests for information about live animal exports which we received on 4 March 2016. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

#### <u>REQUEST I</u>

"Under the Freedom of Information Act I would like to request information on a shipment of live animals. The shipment arrived at Ramsgate Port for export from the UK on 10 March 2014. The vehicle in question had the registrations BT JD 75 for the tractor and OD 39 DD for the trailer.

Please can you provide me with copies of the following paperwork (Please do not redact registration plates from any of this paperwork so that I can see it is connected to the vehicle above):

- 1. The Journey Log (WIT07)
- 2. The Vehicle/Livestock Inspection Report (WIT32)
- 3. All Intra Trade Animal Health Certificates (ITAHC)
- 4. Any WIT08 or WIT09 notices served
- 5. If any animals were refused loading, the ET45 form.

Please could you also advise as to whether the vehicle received an inspection by Animal Health at the Port of Ramsgate and if so for how long?"

This requested information is being withheld under Section 14(2) of the Freedom of Information Act, which relates to a repeated request. On 16 September 2015 APHA provided you the information regarding this vehicle under our reference number ATIC0679. We supplied all information that is being asked for here.

## REQUEST II

"Under the Freedom of Information Act I would like to request information on a shipment of live animals. The shipment arrived at Ramsgate Port for export from the UK on 6 May 2014. The vehicle in question had the registrations BN GV 01 for the tractor and OF 68 RN for the trailer.

Please can you provide me with copies of the following paperwork (Please do not redact registration plates from any of this paperwork so that I can see it is connected to the vehicle above):

- 1. The Journey Log (WIT07)
- 2. The Vehicle/Livestock Inspection Report (WIT32)
- 3. All Intra Trade Animal Health Certificates (ITAHC)
- 4. Any WIT08 or WIT09 notices served
- 5. If any animals were refused loading, the ET45 form.

Please could you also advise as to whether the vehicle received an inspection by Animal Health at the Port of Ramsgate and if so for how long?

This requested information is being withheld under Section 14(2) of the Freedom of Information Act, which relates to a repeated request. On 16 September 2015 APHA provided you the information regarding this vehicle under our reference number ATIC0679. We supplied all information that is being asked for here.

#### REQUEST III

"Under the Freedom of Information Act I would like to request information on a shipment of live animals. The shipment arrived at Ramsgate Port for export from the UK on 19 September 2014. The vehicle in question had the registrations BN GV 01 for the tractor and OK 16 YN for the trailer. Please can you provide me with copies of the following paperwork (Please do not redact registration plates from any of this paperwork so that I can see it is connected to the vehicle above):

- 1. The Journey Log (WIT07) Please see the Journey Log (WIT07) at Appendix 1.
- 2. The Vehicle/Livestock Inspection Report (WIT32) Please see the Vehicle/Livestock Inspection Report (WIT32) at Appendix 2.
- 3. All Intra Trade Animal Health Certificates (ITAHC) Please see the Intra Trade Animal Health Certificate (ITAHC) at Appendix 3.
- 4. Any WIT08 or WIT09 notices served No WIT08 or WIT09 notices were served.
- 5. If any animals were refused loading, the ET45 form. APHA do not hold an ET54 form for this vehicle.

Please could you also advise as to whether the vehicle received an inspection by Animal Health at the Port of Ramsgate and if so for how long?"

APHA inspected vehicle BN GV 01 / OK 16 YN at the Port of Ramsgate. The WIT32 inspection report is at Appendix 4. The length of time for a check is not recorded as APHA are not required to record this information. All checks undertaken at Ramsgate Port take as long as is necessary to complete the check thoroughly, but without causing undue addition to the animal's journey time.

Information has been redacted from the attached Appendices under Section 40(2) and Section 38 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Section 40(2) refers to other people's personal information. Some of the information contained within the requested documents has been withheld under section 40(2) (third party personal data) of the FOIA as the information constitutes personal data relating to a third party. Section 40(2) of the FOIA provides that personal data relating to third parties is exempt information if disclosure would breach the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA).

APHA consider that disclosure of this information is likely to breach the first data protection principle in Schedule 1 of the DPA, which relates to the fair and lawful processing of personal data, in two ways. First, disclosure would not constitute 'fair' processing of the personal data, second, disclosure would not satisfy any of the conditions for data processing set out in Schedule 2 to the DPA. Therefore, we have concluded that this information is exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the FOIA.

Section 38 refers to the exemption from the duty to provide information if it would, or would be likely to affect anyone's health or safety.

We recognise that there is a general presumption in favour of transparency and openness concerning our work, and providing the general public with the right to request access to information held by public authorities.

We also recognise that there is a public interest in disclosure of this specific information in order to increase this transparency and aid well-informed debates concerning the welfare and transportation of animals, and the individuals associated with them.

However, we feel that there is a stronger public interest in withholding the information as the full address of the premises of origin, destination and/or rest stops, transporter details and individual names would identify further information and would, or would be likely to, endanger the health and safety of staff. This poses a substantial risk to the health and safety of individuals associated with the transportation of animals that would be of significant severity and is likely to occur in some cases. We consider this to be a significant factor in favour of maintaining the exemption.

APHA has balanced the real threat to the health and safety of individuals which disclosure of the requested information would be likely to cause, against the public interest arguments in favour of disclosure. In this instance the APHA does not consider that disclosing the information requested in order to inform public debate and to promote accountability and transparency would justify the risk to individuals' health and safety.
