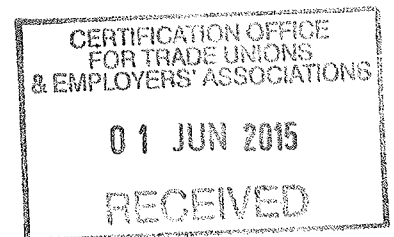

Auditors' Report to the Members of the Warwick International Staff Association

We have audited the financial statements of the Warwick International Staff Association for the period ended 31 December 2014 which comprise the Income and Expenditure Account, Balance Sheet and related notes. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and the accounting policies set out therein.

Our audit work has been undertaken so that we might state to the Council of Management those matters we are required to state to them in an auditor's report and for no other purpose. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we do not accept responsibility to anyone other than the Staff Association and the Staff Association's members for our audit work, for this report or for the opinion we have formed.

Respective responsibilities of officers and auditors

The union's committee is responsible for the preparation of financial statements and the annual return in accordance with applicable law and United Kingdom Accounting Standards.

Our responsibility is to audit the financial statements in accordance with relevant legal and regulatory requirements and United Kingdom Auditing Standards.

We report to you our opinion as to whether the financial statements give a true and fair view and are properly prepared in accordance with the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992. We also report to you if, in our opinion, the Staff Association has not kept proper accounting records, if the Staff Association has not maintained a satisfactory system of control over its transactions, if the general fund and balance sheet are not in agreement with the books of account and if we have not received all the information and explanations we require for our audit.

Basis of audit opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Auditing Standards issued by the Auditing Practices Board. An audit includes examination, on a test basis, of evidence relevant to the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. It also includes an assessment of the significant estimates and judgements made by the officers in the preparation of the financial statements, and whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Staff Association's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

We planned and performed our audit so as to obtain all the information and explanations which we considered necessary in order to provide us with sufficient evidence to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or other irregularity or error. In forming our opinion we also evaluated the overall adequacy of the presentation of information in the annual return.

Opinion

In our opinion the financial statements give a true and fair view, in accordance with United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice, of the state of the Staff Association's affairs as at 31 December 2014 and of its deficit for the year then ended and have been properly prepared in accordance with the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.
