Request for Information

Thank you for your email dated 30 March 2015 requesting information on funding provided to Hastoe Housing Group. For ease of reference your request is below:

"I should like to have details of all government funding received by the Hastoe Group, including Hastoe Housing Association, since the year 2009.

The information required includes not only the specific figures, but also details of the projects for which these sums were destined."

We have now had an opportunity to investigate your request and are writing to communicate our response. Attached to this letter is a spreadsheet which details the funding received by Hastoe Housing Association under the different programmes the Homes and Communities Agency (HCA) ran during the years you requested.

Please note the information provided only goes up to 30 September 2014. Whilst we can confirm that we hold the up to date information, we are unable to provide it to you as it is exempt from disclosure under Section 44 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Section 44 - Prohibitions on disclosure

Section 44 of the FOIA permits a public authority to withhold information if its disclosure is (otherwise than under this Act):

- a) Prohibited by or under any enactment;
- b) Incompatible with any EU obligation; or
- c) Would constitute or be punishable as a contempt of court

Section 44 is an absolute exemption and does not require a public interest test to weigh the balance of factors in favour of disclosure or non-disclosure. The data requested is considered an Official National Statistic. Therefore the post-30 September 2014 information falls within Section 44 (1)(a) as it is protected by the 'Pre-release Access to Official
