

THE DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC FROM JUNCTION WITH MINOR ROAD SOUTH OF WHITE RAKE CONTINUING AS RESTRICTED BYWAY TO JUNCTION WITH BLACK HARRY LANE – PARISHES OF GREAT LONGSTONE AND STONEY MIDDLETON) MODIFICATION ORDER 2014

This order is made by Derbyshire County Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement in respect of the Parishes of Great Longstone and Stoney Middleton require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely, the discovery by that authority of evidence which when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them shows that the right of way referred to in this order which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Derbyshire County Council hereby orders that:

- 1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 26 March 2014.
- The Definitive Map and Statement for the County Of Derbyshire for the Parishes of Great Longstone and Stoney Middleton shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map to the order.
- 3. This order shall take effect on the date when it is confirmed and may be cited as the Derbyshire County Council (Byway Open to all Traffic from junction with minor road south of White Rake continuing as Restricted Byway to junction with Black Harry Lane Parishes of Great Longstone and Stoney Middleton) Modification Order 2014.

Byway Open to All Traffic in the Parishes of Great Longstone and Stoney Middleton from Point A (Ordnance Survey Grid Reference ("GR") SK 1931 7450) in a generally eastwards direction to Point B (GR SK 2033 7439) then continuing east south eastwards as a Restricted Byway in the Parish of Great Longstone to Point C (GR SK 2067 7418), a total distance of 1594 metres or thereabouts.


